

POST TOUR to Stockholm after the OMEP Congress

Program for post conference August 14 – 16, 2010 3 days

Day 1: Saturday August 14

10 am Departure with train from Göteborg Central Station for a four hour trip by train through the Swedish landscape. Arrival at Stockholm Central Station around 2pm.



Check in at Hostel in Stockholm Centre (af Chapman, Röda båten (the Red Ship), STF Fridhemsplan or STF Zinken).

Late afternoon and evening: Sightseeing with guide in the old town of Stockholm.

Day 2: Sunday August 15

The Vasa Museum

The Vasa Museum is Scandinavia's most visited museum, located in Stockholm, capital of Sweden. The Museum was inaugurated in 1990. In the large shiphall stands the warship Vasa - the only remaining, intact 17th century ship in the world. The lower rig has been rebuilt, complete with masts, stays and shrouds.

Just like the Vasa would have looked like when set for winter in harbour. The wreck, salvaged in 1961, is now once again a complete ship.

Skansen, an open air museum The many exhibits over the 75 acre (300,000 m²) site include a full replica of an average 19th-century town, in which craftsmen in traditional dress such as tanners, shoemakers, silversmiths, bakers and glass-blowers demonstrate their skills in period surroundings. An open-air zoo containing a wide range of Scandinavian animals and farmsteads where rare breeds of farm animals can also be visited.

Dinner hosted by the OMEP Stockholm chapter.

We take a short trip by ferry and have a **nice informal OMEP dinner in Nacka.**

Day 3: Monday August 16

Morning: Visits to Preschools in Lidingö and Hässelby with local and OMEP guides.

Afternoon: Visits to **The Workshop** or **The School in the Nature**; pedagogical creative centres for children and teachers within Early Childhood Education.
